THE WAY OF PERSISTENCE IN COMPREHENSIVE MARTIAL ARTS

Rooted in 15th century, Kojido not only tries to revive, restore and promote the core values of Koryu Bujutsu (Traditional Martial Arts), but also scientifically introduces a balance of physical and mental training based on martial reality in a controlled environment for self-defense.

As Kojido is not a martial sport, it focuses on the actual martial strategy, martial science and Japanese martial culture.

Now, on the 12th anniversary of its association formation, Kojido accepts application for representation in Europe, North Africa and East Asia. Applicants with interest to form and conduct a small study group in their local areas must:

- Be adult male or female with no less than 22 years of age;
- Preferably reached black belt (Shodan) in one of the Japanese Martial Arts;
- Be able to travel to Canada for official initiation, when required, as well as for the annual training sessions with the Founder of Kojido.

Note:

Kojido does not participate in any form of tournaments and it does not award Kyu-Dan or color belts. It follows the Japanese 'Warrior Licensing' system and requires practitioners to follow the dress code of wearing Keiko Gi, Kaku Obi and Hakama as specified in its publications.
